It pioneered an advanced multispecialty, ambulatory surgical center in the UP Manila complex, and continues to operate the wellestablished Daniel O. Mercado Medical Center in Batangas. It is recognized with a "Center for Excellence" seal by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth).
