We write in response to your letter dated December 26, 2012 requesting Ayala Land, Inc. ("the Company") to clarify and/or confirm the news article entitled "ALI, RLC eye Boni South Property" posted in philSTAR.com on December 25, 2012. The article reported in part that:

*Property giants Ayala Land Inc. and Robinsons Land Corp. are waiting for the guidelines and terms of reference (ToR) for the bidding of the P13.3 billion Bonifacio South property in Taguig City.*

*The 33.1-hectare property, currently occupied by the Army Support Command and Special Services Unit of the Philippine Army, the Bonifacio Naval Station and the Philippine Marine Corps of the Philippine Navy, will be bid out in the middle of February.*

*ALI President Antonino T. Aquino said the TOR will form the basis of the company's decision whether or not to bid for the property.*

We confirm that at this point, the Company is still waiting for the guidelines and terms of reference for the bidding of the Bonifacio South property in Taguig City, which shall be the basis of our assessment of the viability of this project.
